APRIL MEETING OF THE CNYMAA: THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY PRESIDENT JIM SAIFF AT 7:45. THE MINUTES OF THE MARCH MEETING WERE READ & APPROVED. THE TREASURER'S REPORT WAS MADE WITH CHECKING ACCOUNT BALANCE OF \$275.58 & SAVINGS OF \$3677.39. OUTSTANDING DEBTS CONSIST OF COST OF TROPHIES & AWARDS, THE COST OF WHICH HAS NOT YET BEEN DETERMINED. THE RAFFLE RADIO HAS NOT AS YET BEEN SOLD. THE MEMBER SHIP WAS ASKED FOR A VOLUNTEER FOR THE OFFICE OF SECRETARY & Dave Mathewson agreed to the task. He will assume the duties during the May meeting. COPIES OF LETTERS FROM STARS & THE REBUTTAL FROM ARCS WAS READ TO THE MEETING BY THE PRESIDENT. AS WELL AS A LETTER FROM THE AUBURN CLUB, ALL IN REGARDS TO THE ASSOCIATION CONTRIBUTION TO WALT THRONE'S CAMPAIGN FOR THE DISTRICT VICE PRESIDENCY OF AMA. THE SECRETARY WAS DIRECTED TO SEND A LETTER TO MR. MARA, NY STATE FAIRGROUNDS, REGARDING OUR FUTURE USE OF THE FACILITIES THE ASSOCIATION NOTES THE STARS HAVE PURCHASED THEIR FIELD & ALL THE FOR THE SYMPOSIUM. MEMBERS OF THE ASSOCIATION OFFER THEIR WARMEST CONGRATULATIONS. THERE WERE LETTERS FROM THE MIDSTATE MODELERS & THE STARS OFFERING SUGGESTIONS FOR FUTURE SYMPOSIUM FORMATS. THE ASSOCIA-TION APPRECIATES THESE SUGGESTIONS & VIGOROUSLY SOLICITES EQUAL SUBMISSIONS FROM OTHER MEMBER CLUBS. AFTER DISCUSSION, GUY CUSENZ MADE A MOTION, SECONDED BY JON HOPKINSON, TO PRESENT A PLAQUE, TO COST ABOUT \$25, TO JOHN FRANKE IN APPRECIATION OF HIS WORK. THE SECRETARY IS TO SEND HIM A LETTER, IF WE COULD OBTAIN HIS OUT-OF-STATE ADDRESS, INFORMING HIM & INQUIRING WHEN HE MAY BE IN THE AREA THIS SUMMER FOR PRESENTATION. A MOTION, MADE BY GUY CUSENZ & SECONDED BY CHARLIE WILSON, TO REQUIRE THE APPROVAL OF THE DELEGATES CLUB MEMBERS FOR EXPENDITURE OF SUMS OVER \$200 BY THE ASSOCIATION WAS DEFEATED. A SUGGESTION WAS MADE TO HAVE AN ASSOCIATION SPONSORED AFFAIR AT THE WHITFORD FIELD AT WEEDSPORT. DETAILS LATER. THE ASSOCIATION HAS NOTED THAT THE CHARTER HAS THE MEMBERSHIP TO THE ASSOCIATION OPEN TO CLUBS RESTRICTED TO. AMONG OTHER REQUIREMENTS, CLUBS WITH A REGULAR MEMBERSHIP OF AT LEAST 10 & THAT AT THIS TIME THE AUBURN CLUB DOES NOT MEET THIS CRITERIA. IT WAS CLARIFIED, UPON OPEN DISCUSSION, THAT THIS CONDITION IS TEMPORARY & THAT THE AUBURN CLUB IS CONSIDERED A MEMBER CLUB IN GOOD STANDING. IT WAS ALSO AGREED THAT THE ASSOCIATION MEETINGS WERE & ARE HELD AT WALT'S FOR THE CONVENIENCE OF & WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE DELEGATES & THE ASSOCIATION APPRECIATES THE USE OF THE PREMISES. THE MEETING WAS ADJOURNED AT 10:20PM. NEXT MEETING AT WALT'S ON MAY 20.

GEORGE W. BEERS MINUTES OF THE CNYMAA MAY 20, 1982 THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER AT 8PM BY PRESIDENT JIM SAIFF. THE MINUTES OF THE APRIL MEETING WERE READ & APPROVED WITH THE FOLLOWING CORRECTION: BILL CUMMINGS, NOT CHARLIE WILSON, SECONDED THE MOTION TO REQUIRE CLUB APPROVAL FOR ASSOCAITION EXPENDITURES OVER \$200. THE TREASURERS REPORT SHOWED A BALANCE OF \$234.14 CHECKING & \$3294.95 SAVINGS FOR A TOTAL OF \$3529.09. ALL OUTSTANDING SYMPOSIUM DEBTS, INCLUDING TROPHY COSTS HAVE BEEN SATISFIED WITH THE POSSIBLE EXCEPTION OF A \$90 BILL FROM THE FAIR FOR SECURITY. OF THE ASSOCIATION CONSTITUTION WERE PASSED OUT TO ALL DELEGATES PRESENT. THOSE CLUBS NOT RE-PRESENTED MAY REQUEST A COPY FROM THE ASSOCIATION SECRETARY. FRAN WORTH NOTED THAT HE RE-CEIVED ANOTHER BILL FOR SECURITY FROM THE FAIR FOR THE SYMPOSIUM. GEORGE BEERS WILL CALL THE FAIR TO TRY TO DETERMINE EXACTLY WHAT WE ARE BEING CHARGED FOR. GEORGE BEERS REPORTED THAT AS OF YET HE HAS RECEIVED NO REPLY TO HIS LETTER TO MR. MARA CONCERNING OUR RELATIONSHIP WITH THE ART & HOME CENTER. THE ARCS HAVE PURCHASED THE RAFFLE RADIO FOR \$175. GUY CUSENZ HAS RECEIVED THE AWARD TO BE GIVEN TO JOHN FRANKE. DAVE MATHEWSON WILL WRITE JOHN TO DETERMINE AN APPROPRIATE TIME FOR PRESENTATION. LARRY ABRAHAM MADE A MOTION, SECONDED BY LARRY APPS, TO HOLD AN ASSOCIATION PICNIC ON SUNDAY OCTOBER 3, 1982 AT WHITFORDS AIRPORT. THE MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY. THE ASSOCIATION WILL PROVIDE HOTDOGS, HAMBURGS, & SODA. SALADS, KNIVES, FORKS, PLATES, ETC. ARE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF EACH INDIVIDUAL. THE PICNIC WILL BE OPEN TO ALL ASSOCI-ATION MEMBERS & THEIR FAMILIES. GEORGE BEERS, REPRESENTING OSWEGO VALLEY, REQUESTO A LOAN of \$150, to be repaid in 9 months, from the Association to help cover the cost of replacing THE CLUB MOWER WHICH WAS STOLEN. LARRY APPS MADE A MOTION, SECONDED BY DAVE MATHEWSON, TO LOAN OVM \$150 AT 6% SIMPLE INTEREST FOR 9 MONTHS. THE MOTION WAS PASSED BY ALL THOSE PRESENT. Now that the precedent has been set, the Association will establish a set of guidelines re-GUARDING ASSOCIATION LOANS TO MEMBER CLUBS. GUY CUSENZ REQUESTED THAT WALT THRONE (AMA DIST. II AVP) GIVE AN AMA REPORT AT EACH ASSOCIATION MEETING. WALT AGREED BUT NOTED THAT HE WAS NOT A DELEGATE TO THE ASSOCIATION & BUSINESS REQUIREMENTS MAY PREVENT HIM FROM ATTENDING SOME MEETINGS ESPECIALLY WHEN THEY ARE HELD AT CLUB FIELDS. WALT REPORTED THAT THE FINAL FCC HEARING ON THE FREQUENCY MATTER WAS HELD APRIL 30, 1982. WE SHOULD KNOW SHORTLY THE RESULTS OF THAT HEARING. GROUND BREAKING FOR THE NEW AMA HEADQUARTERS WILL BEGIN SOON & WALT ASKED FOR OUR CONTINUED SUPPORT OF THIS PROJECT. THE SUMMER MEETING SCHEDULE WAS ESTABLISHED & IS AS FOLLOWS: JUNE 17 - STARS FIELD, JULY 15- OSWEGO VALLEY FIEDD, AUGUST 19 - ARCS FIELD, SEPTEM-BER 16 - AUBURN FIELD. THE MEETING WAS ADJOURNED AT 9:45PM. THE NEXT MEETING WILL BE HELD ON JUNE 17 AT THE STARS FIELD AT 8PM. COME EARLY & FLY.

THE 1ST PART OF THIS CATEGORY IS ELECTRICAL; & WE'LL TOUCH ON IT VERY LIGHTLY, SINCE MOST OF YOU DON'T KNOW WHICH END OF A DRY CELL GOES INTO A FLASHLIGHT 1ST. ASK YOURSELF A FEW QUESTIONS. DID THE RADIO WORK CORRECTLY BEFORE YOU INSTALLED IT, & AFTERWARDS TOO? HAVE I CHECKED THE CONDITION OF THE BATTERIES BEFORE & AFTER FLYING, & CHARGING? WHAT'S THE GENERAL CONDITION OF THE RADIO? ARE THE WIRES DIRTY, KINKED, BROKEN, OR FRAYED? ARE THE SERVOS DIRTY, IRREGULAR (USE EXLAX ON THE POT), WORN PUSHROD HOLES OR OILY? IS THE SWITCH OILY OR PACKED WITH DIRT? IF YOU ANSWERED YES TO ANY OF THESE, DO SOMETHING ABOUT IT! How'S YOUR INSTALLATION? A BIT HAPHAZARD? DO YOU EPOXY SERVOS IN BECAUSE YOU CAN'T FIND THE APPROPLATE SIZE SCREWS? ARE YOUR HINGES & LINKAGES SO STIFF THEY COULD USE HYDRAULIC BOOST UNITS? YOU ALL KNOW WHAT A GOOD INSTALLATION LOOKS LIKE, BECAUSE YOU'VE SEEN THEM AT THE FIELD & IN PHOTOGRAPHS IN MAGAZINES. TAKE YOUR TIME, PLAN, WORK CAREFULLY & MAKE A NICE NEAT, SOLID INSTALLATION. AFTER IT IS COMPLETED, TEST IT THOROUGHLY AT HOME BEFORE YOU GET TO THE FIELD. DON'T THROW HALF OF THE UN-INSTALLED RADIO IN TO YOUR FIELD BOX WITH THE THOUGHT IN MIND, "I'LL FINISH IT AT THE FIELD TOMORROW". THERE MAY BE PEOPLE WAITING TO USE THE PIN FOR FLYING WHILE YOU TINKER. OH YES, DON'T FORGET TO CHECK YOUR HINGES TO MAKE SURE THEY'RE STILL SOLIDLY ANCHORED. OK, NOW FOR PART 2 OF THE BYLINE CRASH PREVENTION & ANALYSIS PROGRAM...PILOT ERROR. PARTS OF THIS CATEGORY WOULD BE BETTER TERMED "PILOT POOR JUDGEMENT". EVER SEE SOMEBODY TRY TO SNEAK IN A QUICK MANEUVER WHEN YOU KNEW THEY WERE WAY TOO CLOSE TO THE GROUND, OR MAKE A FINAL APPROACH TURN, DEAD STICK, 6 FEET OFF THE GROUND? THESE ARE EXAMPLES OF POOR JUDGEMENT, ASSUMING OF COURSE THAT YOU ARE NOT A BEGINNER. IT'S NO SECRET THAT PATTERN PEOPLE ARE GENERALLY THE BEST GROUP OF FLYERS. AND ITS ALSO NO SECRET THAT THEY GOT THAT WAY THROUGH PRACTISE. THE OTHER ASPECT OF "POOR JUDGEMENT" THAT WE SEE ON OCCASSION IS SOMEONE ATTEMPTING TO FLY AN AIRCRAFT OUTSIDE OF HIS ABILITY. Now, I KNOW YOU'VE ALL READ, SEEN & HEARD ABOUT THAT LOGICAL PROGRESSION OF AIRCRAFT FROM 2 OR 3 CHANNEL HIGH WING TRAINERS, TO SOME PATTERN BOMB, OR THAT BEAUTIFULLY DETAILED BUT EXTREMELY OVERWEIGHT SCALE MODEL. SO HOW COME SOME OF US TRY TO SKIP SOME OF THE INTERMEDIATE STEPS? I GUESS WE JUST GET IN TOO MUCH OF A HURRY TO FLY A MORE APPEALING AIRCRAFT, & IN THE PROCESS GET SHORT CHANGED ON LEARNED FLYING SKILLS. BETTER TO LEAVE THAT SUPER FAST, HIGHLY LOADED FEENICKS 5 YOU'VE JUST FINISHED HANGING IN THE BASEMENT UNTIL YOUR SKILLS WARRANT. STICK TO THAT GOLDBERG GOBBLER, & ALTHOUGH IT MAY LOOK LIKE A TURKEY WITH ITS FAT WING & SQUARE FUSE-LAGE, IT WILL TEACH YOU THE SKILLS NECESSARY TO MASTER THE FEENICKS 5.
