AMA District II Associate Vice President Report

It's been a long time since I've done one of these reports, at least under the title of Dist II AVP. Now that Dan Williams has relieved me as STARS President, I hope to have time to keep everyone better informed about AMA matters as they pertain to the central New York area.

First item is that GREAT article about the CNYMAA that Charlie Hart had published in the February issue of Model Aviation magazine. Charlie is to be congratulated on an informative and interesting piece on our areas modeling efforts. For your information, from discussions I've had with other modelers throughout the country, I believe we have more clubs, more modelers, more flying fields, more hobby shops, and more non-commercial model aviation activities in our area than in any other area of the country of the same population.

Second item is this years CNYMAA Symposium and Model Show. As you all know, the date is Jan 27, 1990 and the place is the New York State Fairgrounds. Bring your masterpieces for the static display competition and let the public and your fellow modelers see some of the great talent that is out there. There will be a District II AMA meeting conducted by John Byrne, and other AMA officials. In the past I've heard complaints about the content of these meetings. My advice is to come and ask your questions, voice your opinion, and support your AMA. It's easy to complain but it takes effort to make a difference. Who knows, you may learn something, I know I do.

Third item is R/C frequencies and their use in our area. By scanning the airways at my home with the ICOM scanner I've found that there is interference on channels 12, 22, and 40. I would advise you not to buy or use these frequencies at this time. If you have questions or want to borrow the scanner to check your location, just give me a call. I have two AMA scanners and the CNYMAA scanner to loan out. If anyone has questions about the AMA frequency phase-in plan or general questions about the new frequencies, call me or drop me a note, and I'll try to answer them or get the correct answer for you. There is a lot of bad information out there that is just plain wrong. The AMA information in Model Aviation is your best source for the straight scoop on the new frequencies. Also I have an excellent video from the AMA and ACE R/C that you can borrow for a club meeting or just to watch yourself.
