Minutes of 5-8-91 STARS meeting

19 regular, 6 associate, 1 junior members present; also 6 guests. Meeting was called to order by president Dan Williams at 7:13 PM. Minutes of April meeting were approved. Treasurer's report was given by Lon Sauter & approved. Lon reported dues of one member were still outstanding. With receipt of letters of resignation of Mike Vincent and Raymond McQueen, Greg Jagiello and Don Rasmussen become eligible for full membership. Applications for associate membership for James Hahn & Dick Martin and junior membership for Tim Hahn were discussed and approved. Welcome new members.

Association Report: Phil Morgan reported the association AMA affiliation was stil pending. Phil stated the slate for new officers had no candidate for president as Art Arro was not running. Phil reported District II sanctions have not been processed so no sanctioned contests in District II this season. Bob Kirschner new District II contest director. Association still contesting add-on state fee for show security.

AMA report: Lon Sauter reported FCC has rulled transmitters manufactured after 3-1-92 must meet gold standards. Fresent transmitters may be used to 3-1-98.

Field report: Bob Prugger reported 36 yards of crushed rock was spread on the field parking area last Saturday. Thanks to all members who helped shovel & rake the area and a special thanks to John Everson for his help with his bucket equipped tractor. Bob reported topscil for the field was the next project. It was agreed to plan delivery of topscil Saturday, 5-11-91, and volunteers would be needed with rakes, shovels & carts to spread the topscil. Discussion for seeding followed (State Fair mix suggested); Bob Prugger offered to secure seed. Dan Williams volunteered to secure peat moss for covering seeded areas. Bob stated estimate for pavillion renovations were at about \$800. & would be considered at later date.

Safety Officer: Art Rose reminded all fliers to place transmitters in impound and only remove when proper frequency pin is available. Return transmitter & pin to impound after flight.

Flight school: Dave sikorski reported first session on 5-1-91 was cancelled due to weather and was rescheduled for Saturday, 5-4-91. Dave reported 17 students were enrolled and more instructors would be helpful. He suggested other members could help with ground

checks and student preparation.
Old Business: Motion from previous meeting to recind dues reduction for meeting attendance was brought up, discussed and approved. Phil Morgan reported 10 members had ordered club jackets. He will contact purchasers when they are ready. Members wishing to purchase jackets should contact Phil. Dan Williams promised new field lock combinations will be included with next issue of Prop Wash for club members. Dan stated he has new windscck for pavillion. Phil Morgan will order P51 windvane for pavillion.



Meeting was adjourned at 8:23 PM.






